Spinning Suns

Bring the sunshine inside with your own spinning sun that isn't just fun to make, but also fun to play with.



Materials:

- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Paper/Construction Paper
- Glue Stick
- Markers/Pencil Crayons/Crayons
- String

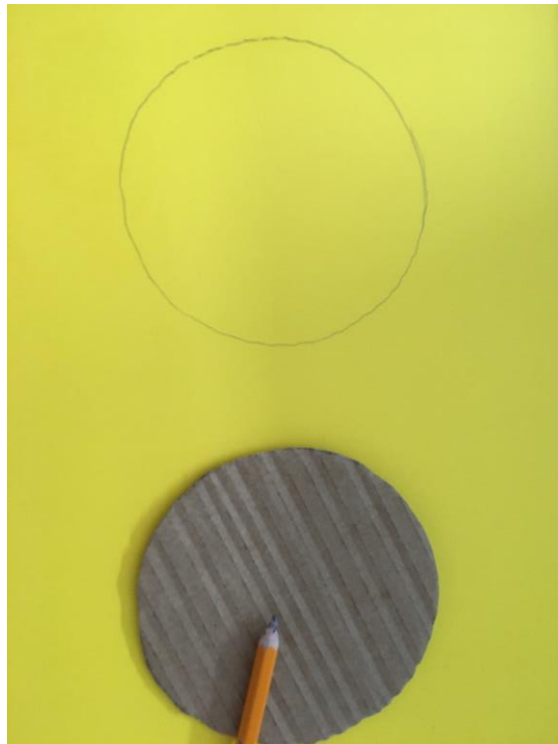
Step 1:

Use something round to trace a circle onto a piece of cardboard then cut it out.



Step 2:

Trace your cardboard circle out on your paper twice (once for the front and once for the back).

Step 3:

Cut out your paper circles and use markers/pencil crayons/crayons to draw a different sun on each circle.



Step 4:

Glue each circle onto your cardboard circle (one on the front and one on the back).

Step 5:

With the help of an adult, poke 2 holes in the centre of your circle. The holes should be close to the middle and near each other.



Step 6:

Cut your string into a piece approx. 28 – 30 inches in length.

Step 7:

Feed your string through one hole then the other and tie the ends of the string together.



Step 8:

Hold both ends of the string and twirl your wrists in circles to get the string twisted. Once twisted, alternate gently pulling and relaxing the string to make your sun spin.
