

Aerial Snow People

Step-by-Step Instructions

Everything looks different from a birds-eye-view. See for yourself as you make a snow person from an aerial perspective.

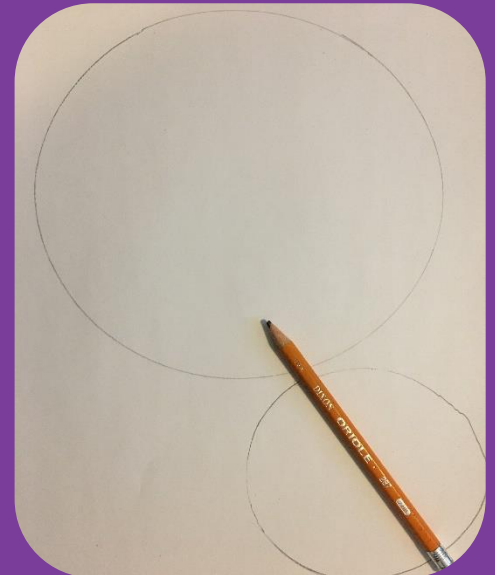


To complete this activity, you will need:

- White paper/cardstock
- Construction Paper
- Crayons/Oil Pastels/Markers
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue Stick

1.

Draw out the different sized circles you'll need to make the 3 balls of your snow person on white paper/cardstock. Each ball should be a different size (i.e. 7", 5" and 2")



2.

On your construction paper, draw a circle that is larger than your smallest ball and slightly smaller than your medium ball (i.e. 3") and a little extra from scraps that will be the ends blowing in the wind. You will also need carrot nose and sticks for the arms



3.

With your crayons/pastels/markers, decorate your different circles with shaded colour around the edge of the balls of your snow person and a pattern on your scarf.



4.

Cut-out and glue all of your shapes, one at a time, onto a base piece of construction paper. Start with your largest ball, then move to the middle, then your scarf pieces and finish with your head piece. Be sure to add your extra pieces for your snow person's arms and nose.



5.

Use your crayons/pastels/markers to add any finishing touches to your snow person (like buttons and eyes).

With that, your aerial perspective of a snow person is complete!
