## Materials:

- Paper
- Corn Syrup
- Food Colouring
- Crayons
- Paint Brushes/Q-Tips

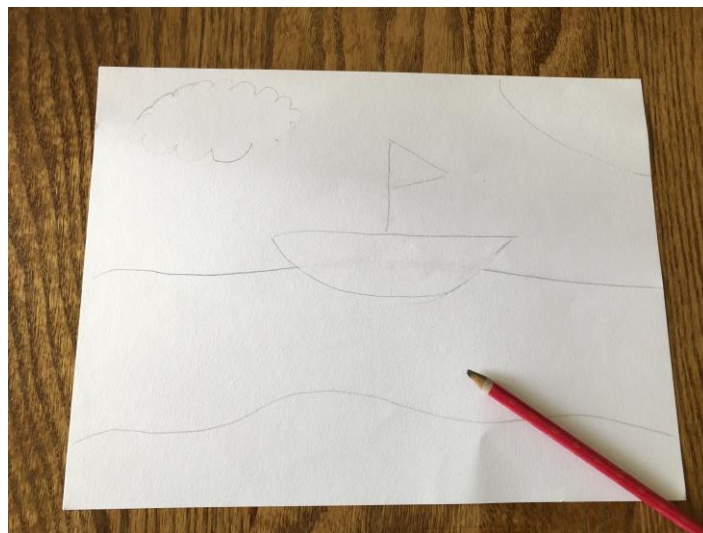
### Step 1:

Using a mini-muffin tin, pour 1.5 tbsp of corn syrup into a each hole. Be sure to only pour as many holes as colours you would like to use. Add 2-3 drops of food colouring into the corn syrup and mix well with your paintbrush/q-tip.



### Step 2:

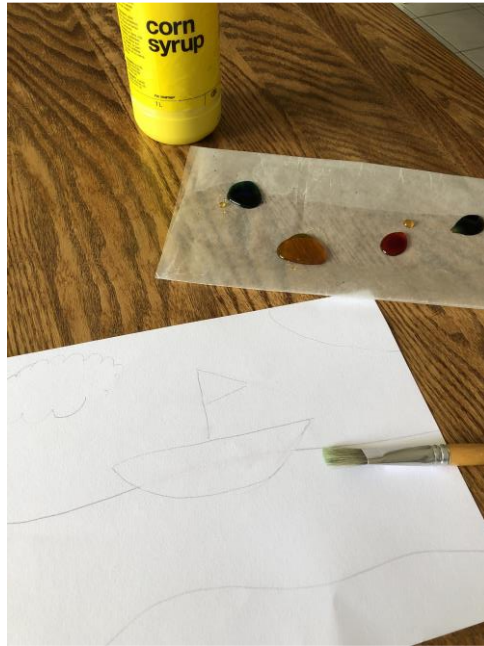
Use your pencil to draw your landscape background. Use your imagination to create the scene of your painting. Are you on the beach? In the forest? Under the sea?
