## Materials:

- Cardstock
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Markers/pencil crayons/crayons
- Scissors

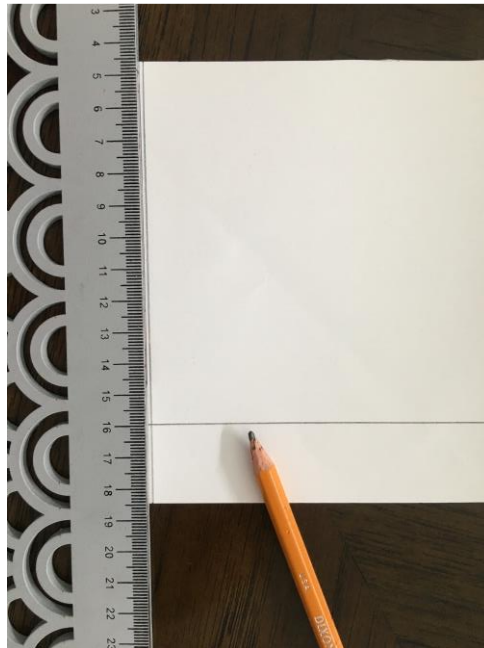
**Step 1:**

Cut your piece of cardstock to the desired size of your postage stamp.



**Step 2:**

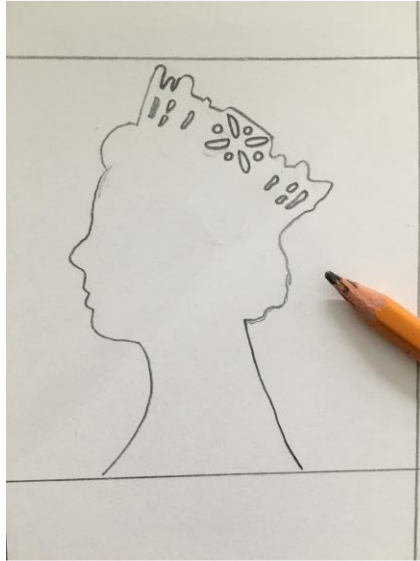
Use a ruler to draw a border around the edge of your paper.

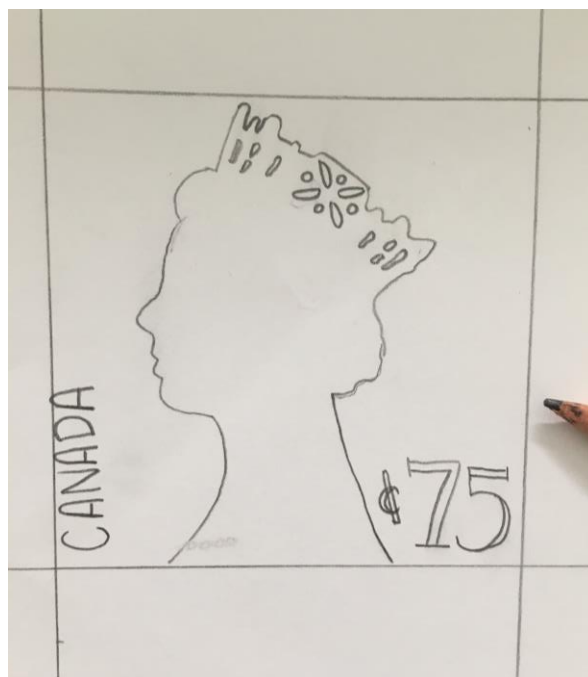
### Step 3:

Use your imagination to draw a profile in the centre of your stamp. Remember, most royals wear their crowns for such occasions. If you need some help, use a flashlight to get your own profile and have someone help you trace your shadow.



### Step 4:

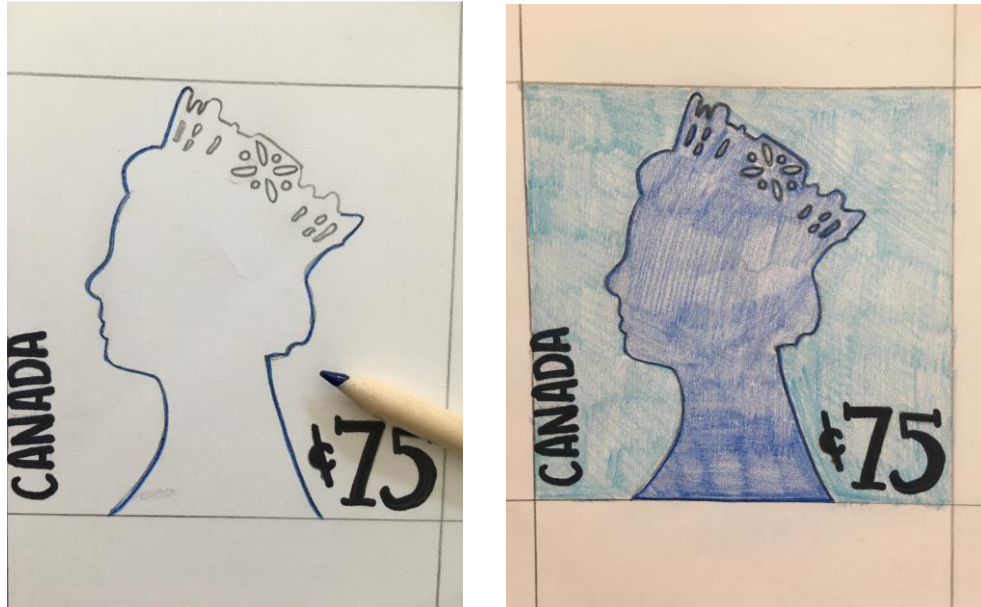
Stamps need to show how much they cost and where they are from, so be sure to add them to the area around your profile.

**Step 5:**

Use markers to outline parts of your stamp to make them stand out. Then, use pencil crayons/crayons to decorate the rest inside your border.



**Step 6:**

Once you are finished decorating the inside of your stamp, add colour to your border.

### Step 7:

After your stamp is full of colour, use scissors to cut around your border – a lot of old stamps have a scalloped edge. Once you have finished cutting it out, your postage stamp profile artwork is complete.
