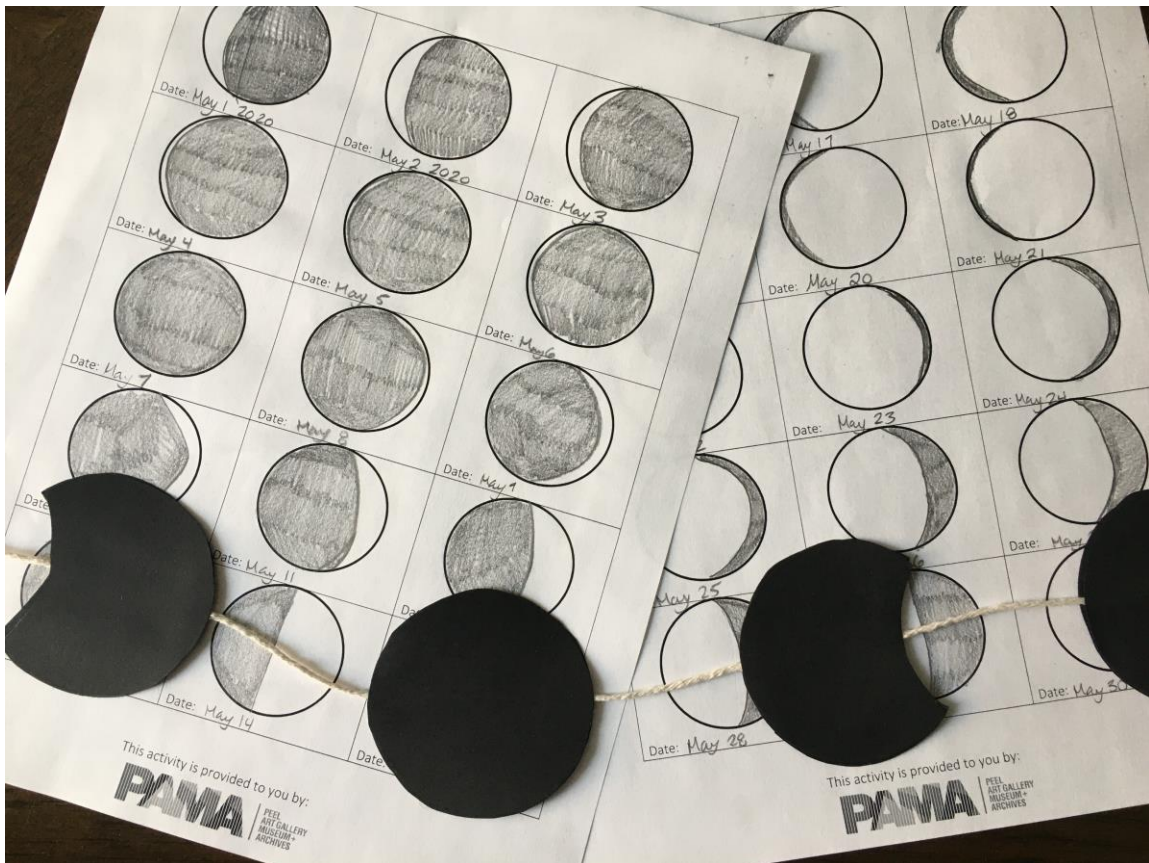
### Phases of the Moon

# Phases of the Moon

Look up at the moon and watch as it changes throughout the month. From a small sliver to full and bright, create your own moon journal to track the moon's progression and bring it to life with a phases garland.



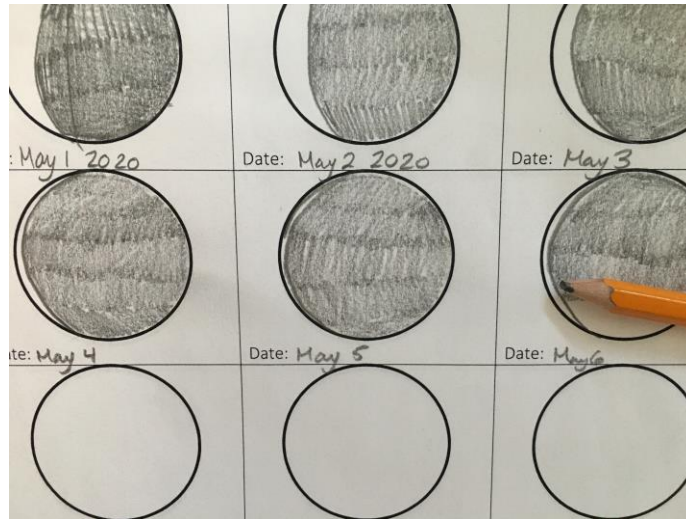
## Materials:

- Moon Journal Sheet (last page of document)
- Pencil
- Construction Paper
- Scissors
- Glue
- String

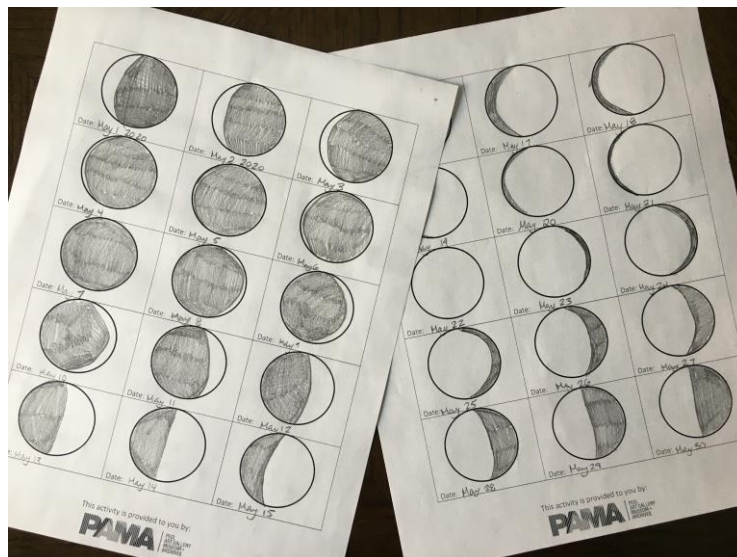
### Step 1:

Print the moon journal sheets. Every night for a month, look outside once it's dark to see the moon and colour-in your daily moon to reflect the phase you see. If it's cloudy, that's ok, draw it!



### Step 2:

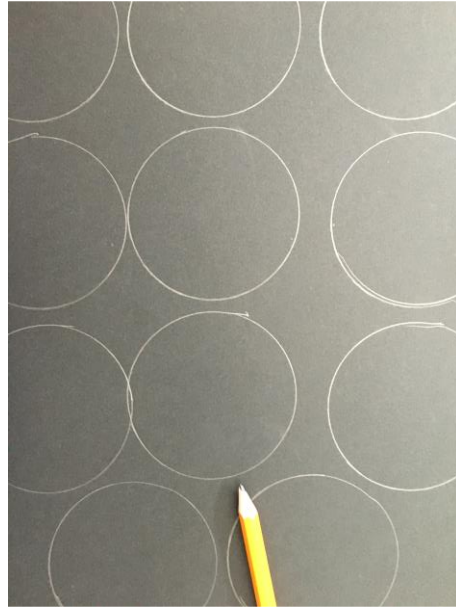
Once you have mapped a month of moon phases, explore what they mean and use the resources linked on page 6 to learn more.



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**Step 3:**

Now it's time to transform your phases of the moon into a unique lunar garland. Take a piece of construction paper and trace twice as many circles as moon phases you'd like on your garland. For example if you want to have a garland of 7 phases, draw 14 circles.



**Step 4:**

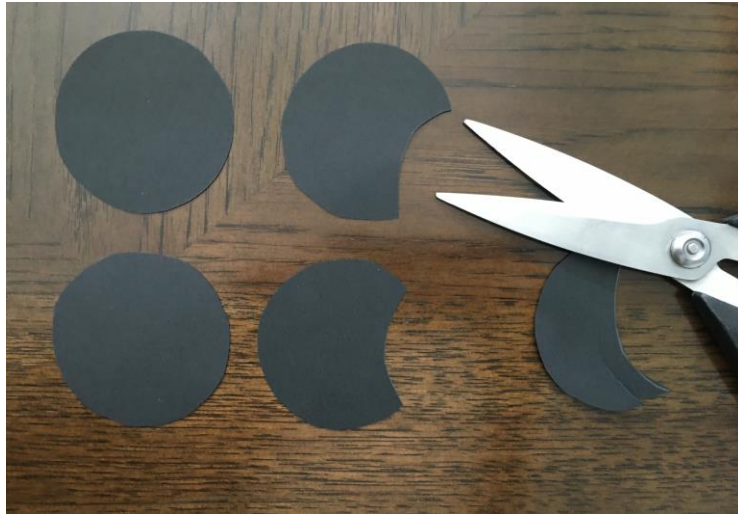
Once drawn, copy the phases of the moon from your journal and draw the lines on your circles accordingly. Draw two of every phase.



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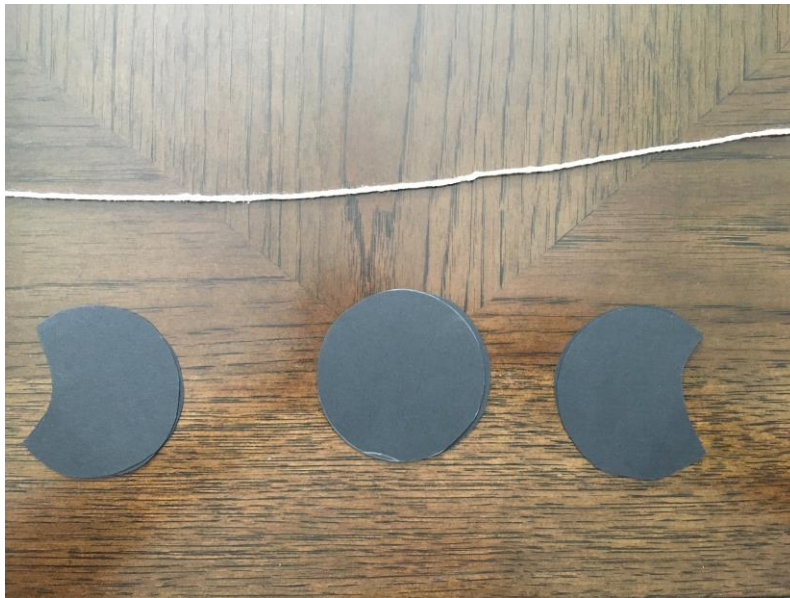
**Step 5:**

Once all your moon phases are drawn, use scissors to cut them out.



**Step 5:**

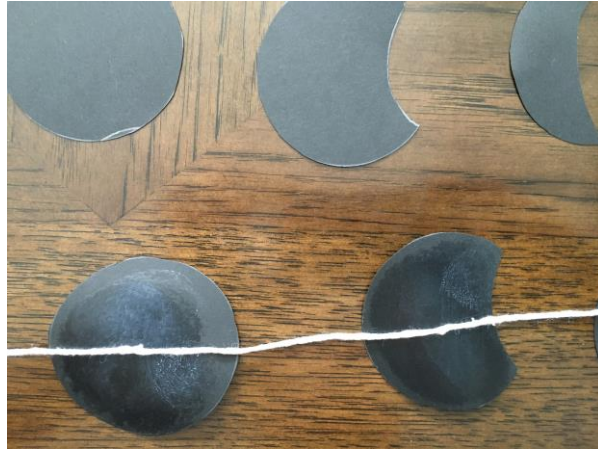
Pair together matching phases and cut your string the desired length of your garland.



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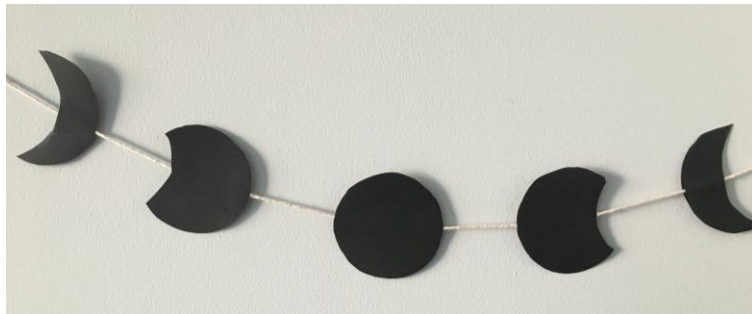
**Step 6:**

Glue the back of one of each phase and lay your string across the backs making sure to space them apart as you'd like.



**Step 7:**

Glue the back of your second phases and press them onto the backs of the first phases and your garland is complete.
















