We need bees to pollenate flowers and help nature grow. Explore all that bees do for us as you create your own honeycomb hive.



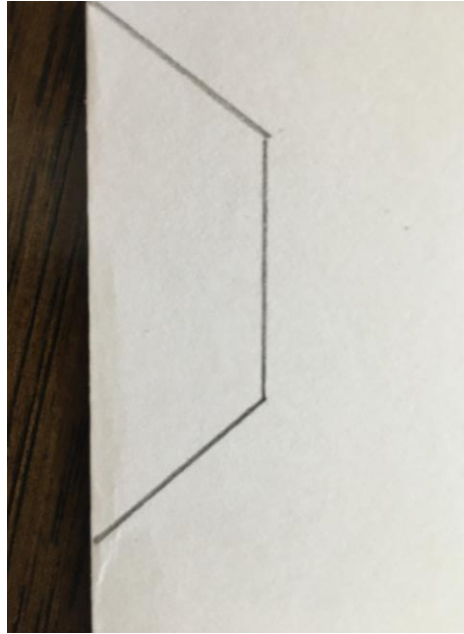
Materials:

- Cardstock/Thin Cardboard
- Construction Paper/Scrapbook Paper
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Markers

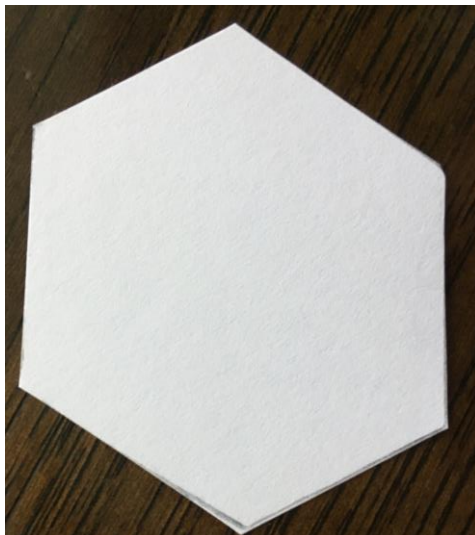
Step 1:

Fold a small piece of cardstock/cardboard in half and draw half of a hexagon with a ruler along the crease.



Step 2:

Use scissors to cut it out, this will be your stencil.



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Step 3:

Use your stencil to trace your hexagon shape onto your construction paper/scrapbook paper.



Step 4:

Once traced, cut all your individual shapes out.



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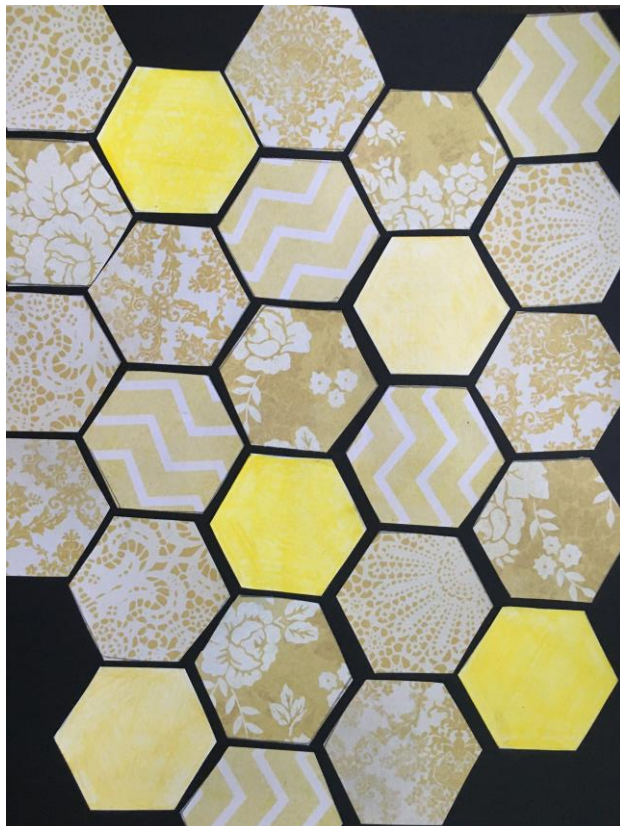
Step 5:

One at a time, glue your hexagon shapes onto a piece of paper. Be sure to line up the edges of shapes and leave a slight gap in between.



Step 6:

Continue gluing until your whole sheet is covered in a honeycomb pattern.



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Step 7:

Once your sheet is filled, research and add some interesting facts about honeybees to your honeycomb hive.



Step 7:

Draw, cut and glue a little honeybee onto your hive and your artwork is complete.



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
