Scratch Art Fireworks

Materials:


- Cardstock
- Crayons
- Black Acrylic/Tempera Paint
- Paint Brush
- Toothpick/Skewer



Step 1:Use your crayons to colour in blocks on your piece of cardstock. Be sure to press hard.



Step 2: Create a colourful pattern as you fill your whole sheet with different colours.







Step 3: Once covered, paint a thin layer of black paint on top of your coloured paper.



Step 4:Cover your entire sheet with black paint and set aside to dry.





Step 5:Once dried, take a toothpick/skewer and use it to scratch firework patterns out of the black paint to expose the colourful crayons underneath.



Step 6:Continue until your whole page is covered with festive fireworks!
