# 3-D Crowns

Feel like royalty as you get creative and make your own 3-dimensional paper crown.



## Materials:

- Construction Paper/Cardstock
- Scissors
- Tape/Stapler/Glue Stick
- Markers/pencil crayons/crayons

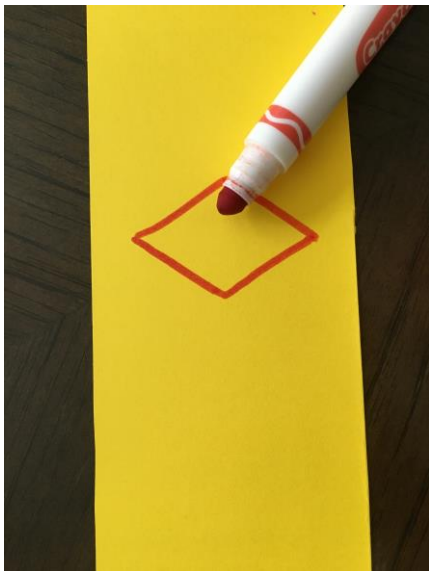
**Step 1:**

Cut your first sheet of construction paper horizontally into 3-inch strips.



**Step 2:**

Attach 2 pieces of the same width together and use markers/crayons/pencil crayons to decorate your crown with jewels.

**Step 3:**

Take your second piece of construction paper and horizontally cut it into 6 strips approx. 1-inch in width.



**Step 4:**

Using tape/stapler/glue attach the ends of your decorated strip to one another. Before securing the ends, measure around your head to make sure it fits. Then one at a time, attach two of the smaller strips horizontally then vertically across the top of your circle, making a cross-shape in the middle.

**Step 5:**

Take another 4 strips and tape/staple/glue one end in-between the crossed strips, leave the other end unattached.



**Step 6:**

One at a time, attach the other ends to the top of the crossed strips, stacking one on-top of the other.

If desired, add a final shape on top of the crown and you are officially royal.
