# Fiesta Flowers

Celebrate Cinco de Mayo by creating your own colourful bouquet of fiesta flowers.



## Materials:

- Coloured Tissue Paper
- Scissors
- String

This activity is provided to you by:

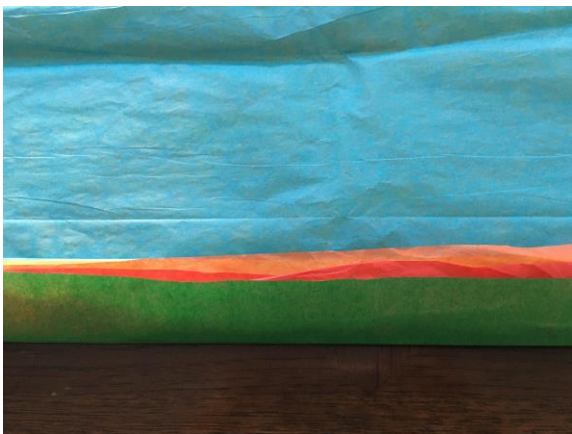
**Step 1:**

Stack all your sheets of tissue paper. The more sheets you use, the fuller your flowers will be. A minimum of 5 sheets is recommended.



**Step 2:**

Once stacked, accordion fold the tissue paper horizontally by alternating folding one side on top of the other. Continue until you are left with one long rectangular strip.

**Step 3:**

Tie a piece of string in the middle of your folded tissue paper. The string should be long enough to hang your completed flowers with.



**Step 4:**

Use your scissors to cut the ends of your tissue paper into a rounded or triangular shape. This shape will be the ends of your flower petals.

**Step 5:**

Gently pull one layer of tissue paper at a time away from the centre string. Continue pulling each layer until your flower is full.



**Step 6:**

Use the string to hang your flowers however you would like and let the fiesta begin!
