Your eyes are a window to the world and are unique colours, shapes and sizes. Explore the beauty of an eye with your own ocular origami.



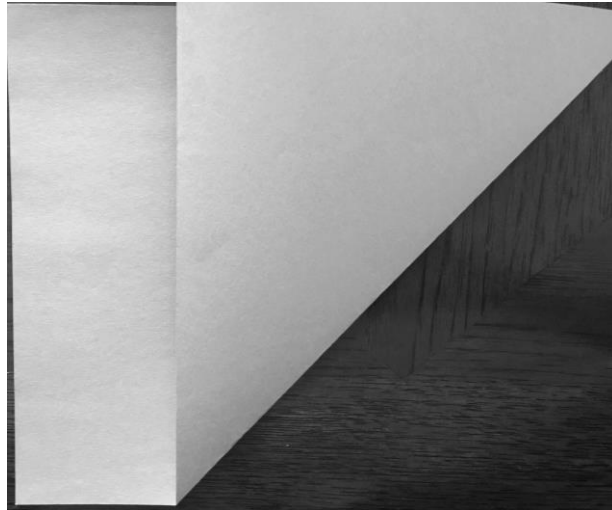
Materials:

- Paper
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Markers/Pencil Crayons/Crayons

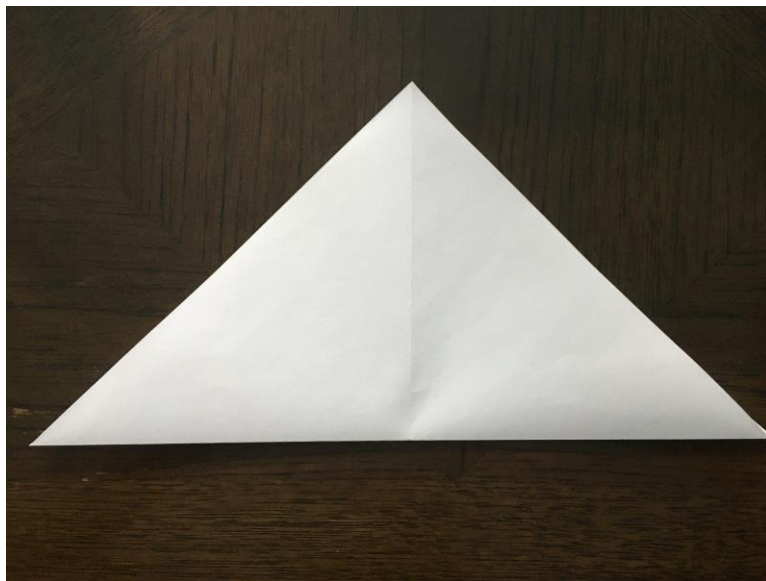
Step 1:

Take a full sheet of paper and fold one corner inwards to make a triangle and cut-off the excess paper to form a square.



Step 2:

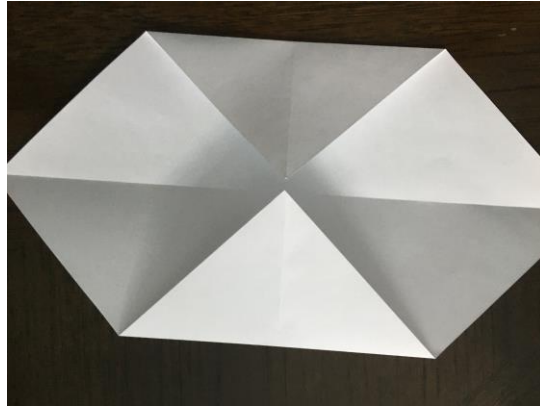
Fold your square of paper in half from corner to corner then half again to make creases in your paper.

Step 3:

Fold two opposite corners inwards towards the centre of your paper.



Step 4:

Fold the top and bottom pieces in half.



Step 5:

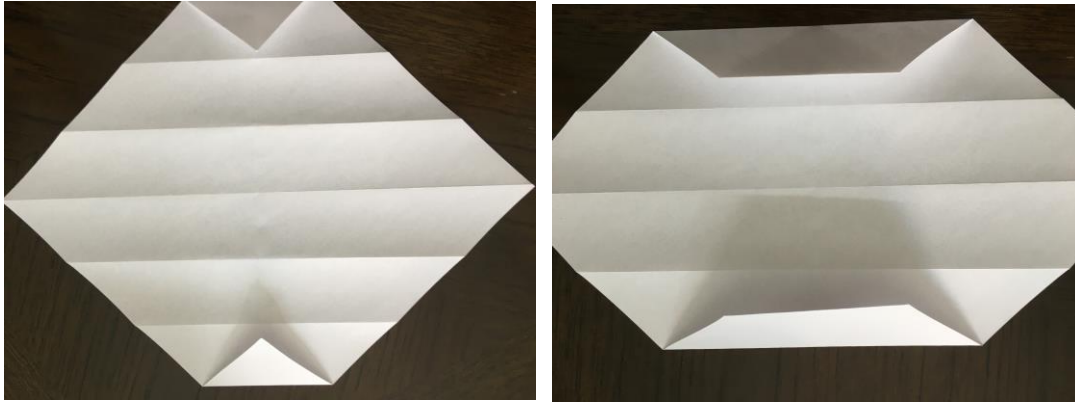
Unfold your paper so all made creases are visible.

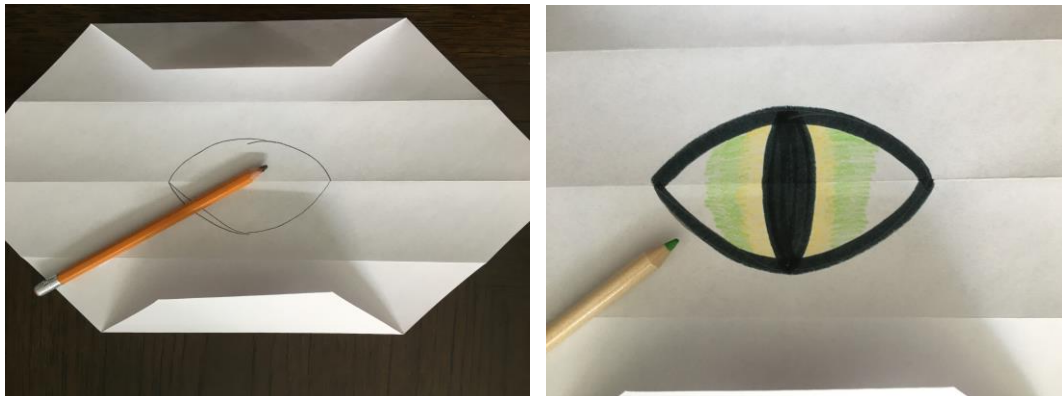
Step 6:

Starting at the corners, refold one section at a time from both the top and bottom.



Step 7:

After 2 folds, draw an eye in the centre of your paper and decorate it with markers/pencil crayons/crayons.



Step 8:

Once coloured-in, fold the last section of your paper over the eye.

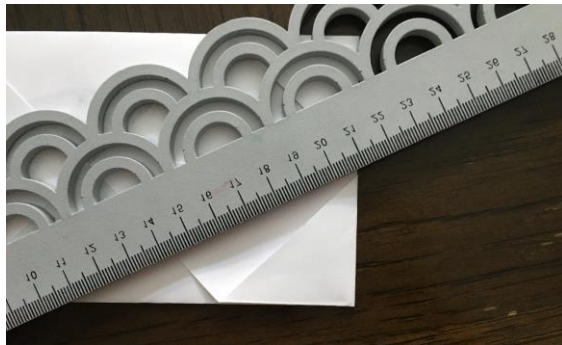
Step 9:

Flip your paper over and fold each end into the centre.



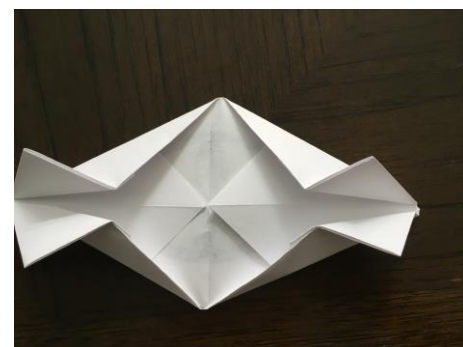
Step 10:

With the help of a ruler, fold from the centre of each edge on an angle to the centre of your paper. Repeat on the top and bottom of both sides.



Step 11:

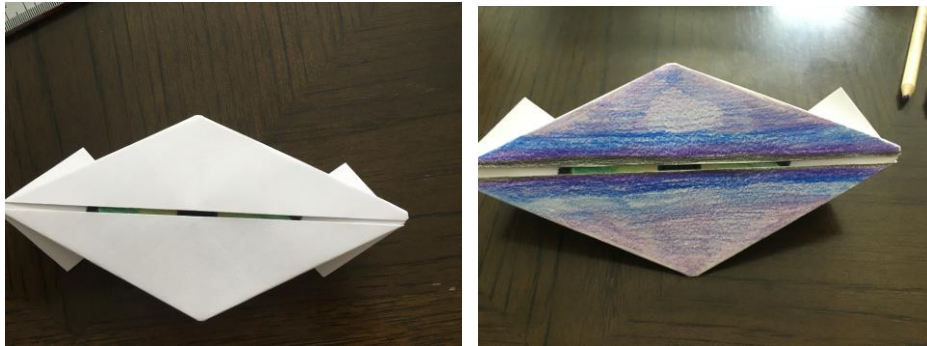
Fold the paper that crosses the centre line back onto the top or bottom of the paper.

Step 12:

Flip your paper back over and use your markers/pencil crayons/crayons to decorate the front as an eyelid.



Step 13:

As you pinch the folded paper on the back into itself, the eyelid will open and show the eye inside.
