Sundials

Learn how to tell time with nothing but the light of the sun as you create your own colourful sundial and explore different kinds of clocks.



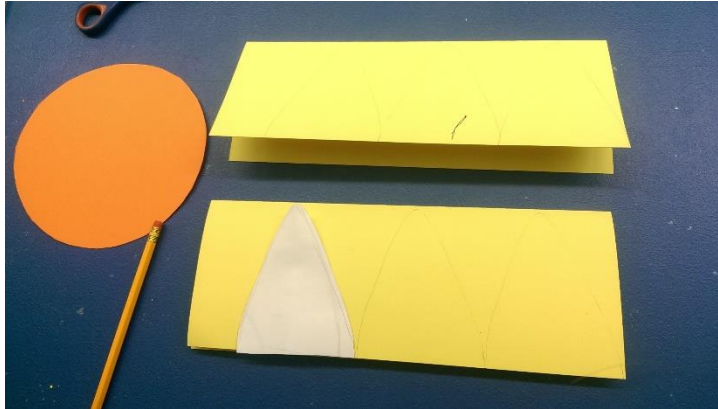
Materials:

- Markers
- Cardstock Paper
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Straws
- Tape

This activity is provided to you by:

Step 1:

Draw a large circle on a piece of cardstock. If you would like to make one that looks like a sunflower, you can also draw 12 flower petal shapes.



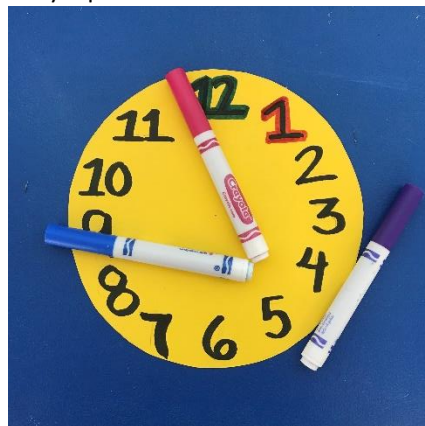
Step 2:

Cut out the shapes with scissors and glue them together (if necessary).



Step 3:

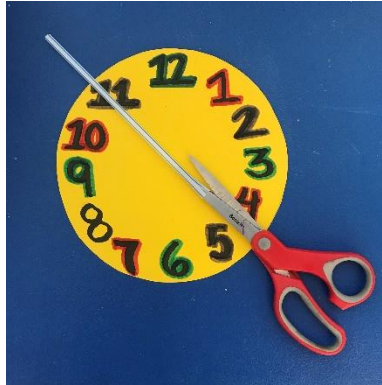
Write the numbers 1-12 evenly spaced around the sundial.

Step 4:

Make 3-4 small cuts up the end of your straw so they can be spread out and taped down. Cut a small hole in the middle of your sundial that would fit the straw.



Step 5:

Feed the straw through the hole in the centre of your sundial and tape the spread end of your straw to the base. Finish by decorating your sundial however you'd like.



To tell the time, place your sundial outside on a sunny day making sure the number 12 is facing north and watch the dial move with the sun throughout the day to show you the time to the hour.
