

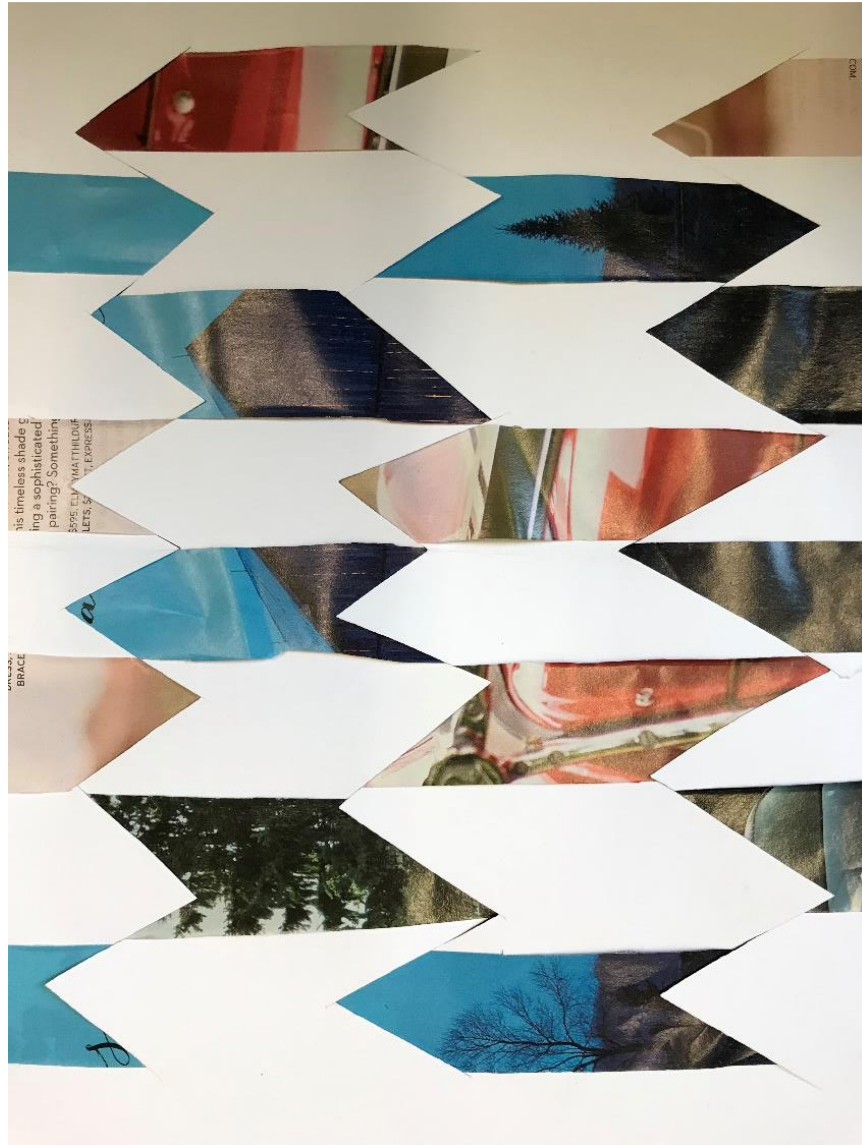

Recycled Weavings

Reduce, reuse and weave! Find a use for the random scraps of paper or old magazines you have in the house and create a recycled woven artwork.



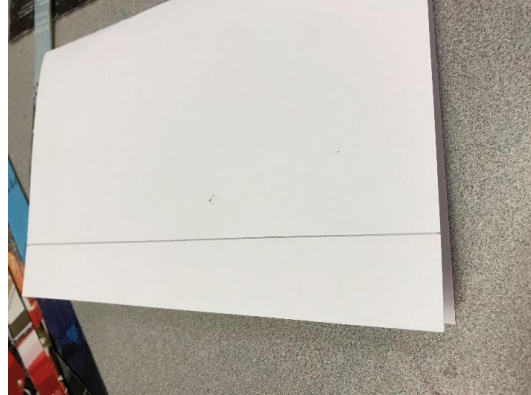
Materials:

- Paper
- Magazines/Long scraps of paper
- Scissors
- Glue Stick
- Pencil
- Ruler

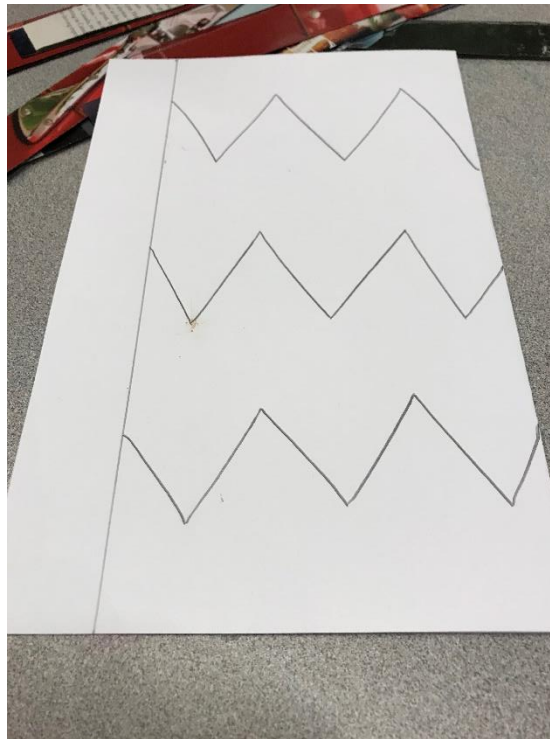
Step 1:

Create your outline by taking your paper and folding it in half lengthwise. Once folded, use your ruler to draw a line down the length of the paper near the open edge.



Step 2:

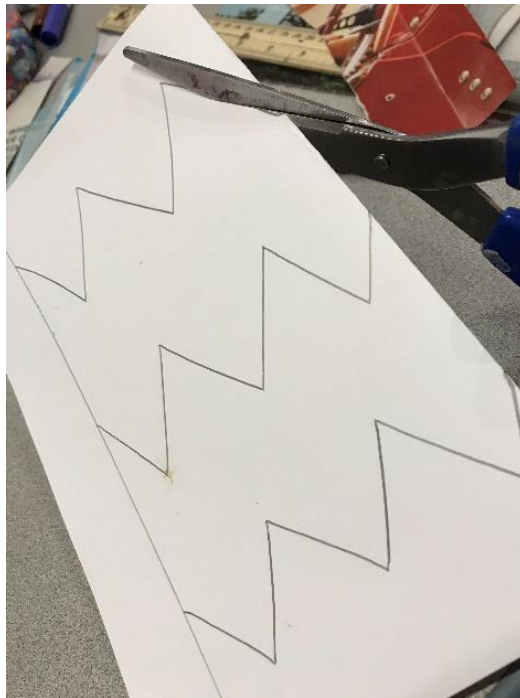
Next, draw zig-zagged lines across your paper from your drawn line to the centre of your folded page. Create 3-4 evenly spaced zig-zags for a simple weave or 6-7 to make it more difficult.

Step 3:

Keep the paper folded, and cut along your zig-zagged lines. Be sure to stop when you reach your border. Once all lines are cut, carefully unfold your paper.



Step 4:

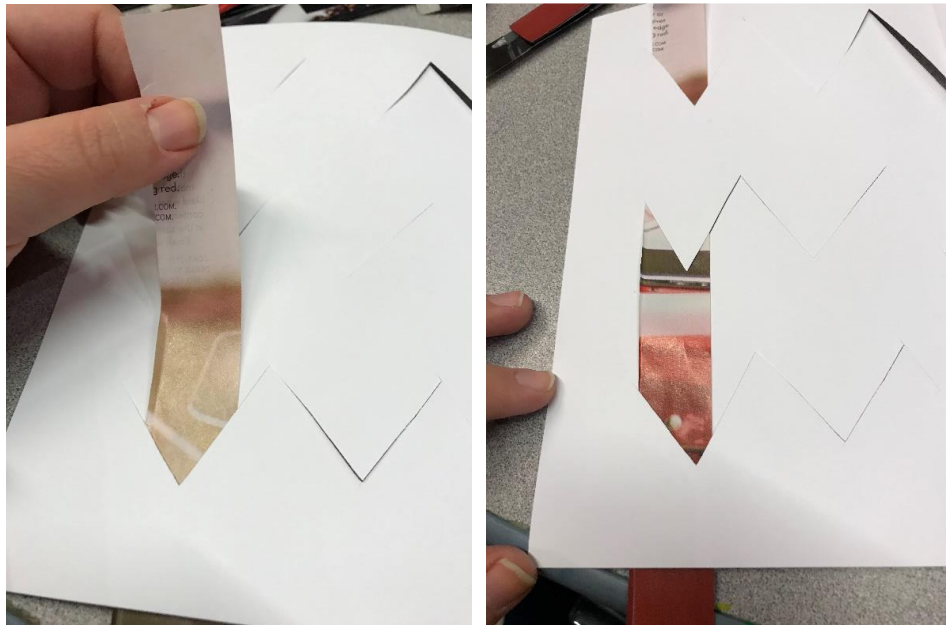
Take either your magazine pages or the scrap paper you plan to use and cut your page into 8-12 strips lengthwise. Try to ensure that they are all the same size.

Step 5:

Now it's time to start to weave! Take one strip and weave it through your zig-zagged slits alternating going over and under.



Step 6:

Once your first strip is done, weave the opposite order with your second strip. If your first one went over then under, this time start under then go over. Continue weaving in an alternating pattern until your sheet is full.

Step 7:

When you have filled your sheet, glue down the ends of each strip. If your strips are too long, trim them with your scissors so they match your piece of paper.
