







Charles Wilson Frank Herd and Ruth Wilson did on or about the 2nd day of January 1921 at the township of Toronto in the County of Peel did wilfully take and steal one spot light, one rope, one umbrella, connections for an air pump, one camera, one inner tube, one auto jack, one kit of tools for automobile, one fan belt, one oil can, one brown kit bag containing tire repair, small hand spotlight with connections and the said Chas A McFarland saith upon his oath that he had just reason to believe and suspect that the said goods are concealed in or about the premises of the said Chas Wilson at the township of Toronto.
