In addition to his broadcast work, Chuck has produced and directed educational films for art galleries, museums and theatres, nationally and internationally.

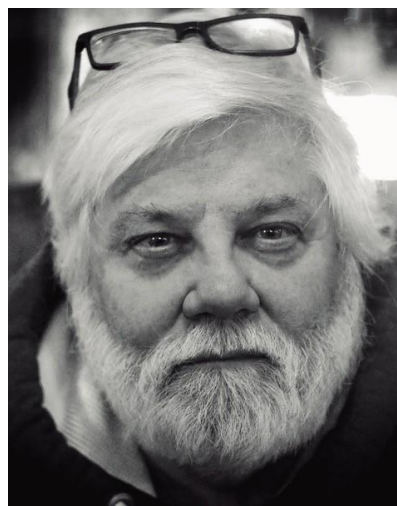
