



Canada Day Decor

Celebrate Canada Day as you create your own paper wreath to decorate your door.




Materials:

- Red & White Construction Paper
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Glue Stick/White Glue
- Cardboard/Foam
- Ribbon/String



Step 1:

Use a ruler to measure 7cm by 7cm squares on a sheet of red construction paper. Then, measure 10 cm by 10 cm squares on 2 sheets of white construction paper.



Step 2:


Once drawn, use scissors to cut all squares out.





Step 3:

Once all your squares are cut out, use a glue stick to adhere the squares in a cone shape by rolling one corner using your index finger and thumb. Hold the cone in place for a few minutes to let the glue dry.



Step 4:


Continue until all squares have been rolled into cones.





Step 5:

Draw a circle on a piece of cardboard/foam and cut it out.



Step 6:


One at a time, glue the white cones around the circle with their points meeting in the middle.





Step 7:

Once all your white cones are in place, glue the red cones in the gaps between two white cones.



Step 8:

Draw, cut-out then glue a small maple leaf in the centre of your wreath, a string/ribbon on the back and you are ready to celebrate Canada Day!
