

Coffee Filters

Markers

Materials:

Use washable markers in Fall colours to cover your coffee filters with colour.

- 1. Start with one colour at a time and add it in blotches all over your coffee filter.
- 2. Change colours and cover other sections
- 3. Continue until your whole coffee filter is covered in colours. getting bigger as you go!

Note: Be sure to put a piece of paper under your coffee filter as you colour so the colour doesn't bleed onto your table!
