Colourful Collages

Explore colour and space as you create your own colourful collage using mixed media techniques inspired by Simon Hughes.

Materials:


- Paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Magazines

- Glue Stick
- Construction Paper/Cardstock
- Markers/Pencil Crayons/Crayons



Step 1:

Use a pencil to draw a shape or the silhouette of something (i.e. an animal) on a piece of paper.



Step 2: Once drawn, use scissors to cut it out.






Step 3:

Look though magazines to find either pieces the same colour, but different shades, or a variety of colours, and cut all your found pieces into strips.



Step 4:

Using your glue stick, glue your magazine pieces on to your cut-out shape. Be sure to cover it completely so there is no white space showing. You can put them all in the same direction or glue them at different angles.






Step 5:

Once your shape is fully covered, flip it over and trim-off the magazine ends so you are left with your original shape.



Step 6:

Glue your shape onto a piece of construction paper or cardstock.





Step 7:

Use a marker/pencil crayon/crayon to play with the space around your shape and add patterns to cover the rest of your page to showcase the positive and negative space around your colourful collage.
