




Get into the Halloween Spirit with your own spooky haunted paper

Step One: Start Your Base

Fold your sheet of paper in half horizontally.

Starting on the folded edge, use your ruler to draw lines approx. 1 inch apart leaving ½ an inch from either edge of the paper.

Materials: Construction Paper Stapler

- Glue Stick
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Pencil Crayons/ Markers/ Crayons Electric Tealights

Step Two: Character Creation

Turn your paper vertically and draw the features of your desired characters on your paper.

You can also use other pieces of construction paper and glue them on.
