It's Raining Petals

Bring May flowers inside one petal at a time as you create your own hanging wisteria garland.



Materials:

- Tissue Paper
- Scissors
- String/Yarn/Thread
- Needle/Bobby Pin

This activity is provided to you by:

Step 1:

Fold one sheet of tissue paper in half five times so you have a rectangle approx. 3 inches by 5 inches



Step 2:

Cut a petal shape out of your tissue paper. Once cut out, you should have a stack of flower petals.



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Step 3:

One petal at a time, gently twist the end and tuck the twisted piece up into the body of the petal. Use your fingers to shape the petal around the newly made curvature.



Step 4:

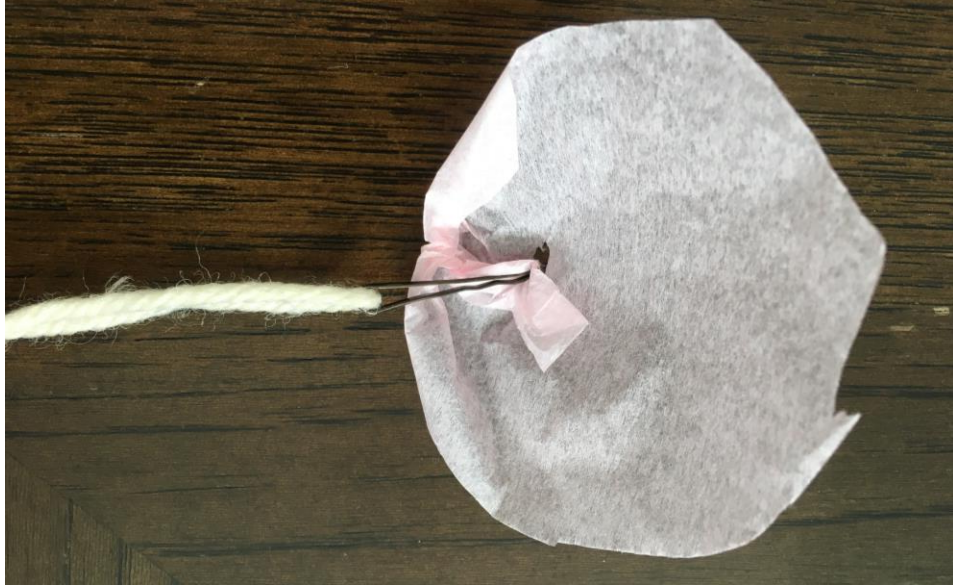
Cut a piece of string/yarn/thread the desired length of your wisteria. Tie a large knot at one end and feed the other end through your needle/bobby pin.



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Step 5:

Pierce your needle/bobby pin through the twisted end and bottom edge of your petal.



Step 6:

Gently pull your petal down the string to the knot at the bottom. Continue cutting and feeding petals on one at a time until you have reached your desired length.



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Step 7:

You will need to cut more petals depending on the length and quantity of wisteria you'd like. Tie all your finished flowers to a piece of string and hang it wherever you would like to bring May flowers inside.



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
