Use your imagination and design your own museum! From the colour of the walls to what's in the frames and display cases -use your imagination and make your museum your own.



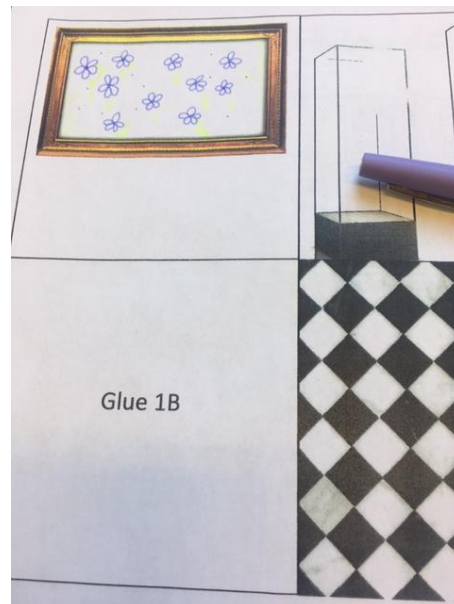
Materials:

- Markers/Crayons/Pencil Crayons
- Scissors
- Glue Sticks

Step 1:

Print the museum templates. Use markers/pencil crayons/crayons to colour in your museum. Add drawings to the frames and items inside the display cases.



Step 2:

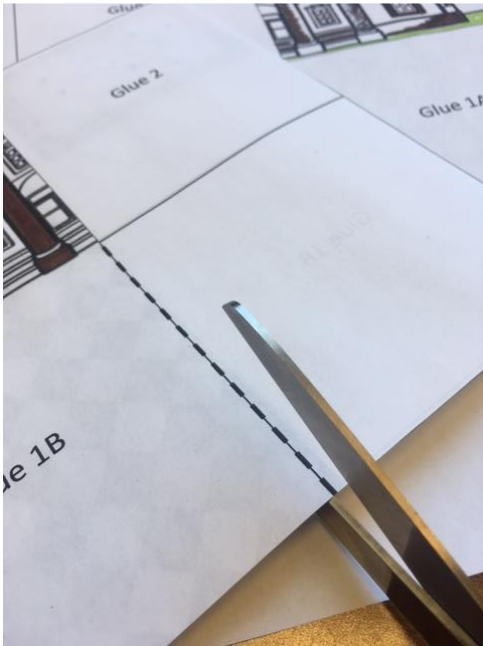
Cut around the edges of the museum and glue page 1 to page 2 back to back and page 3 to page 4.

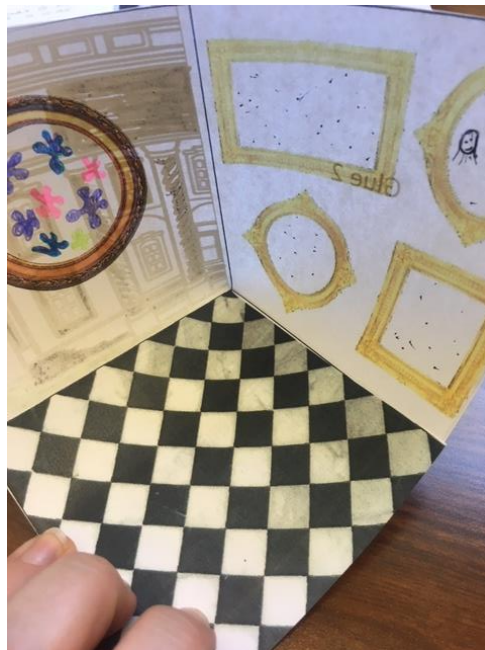
Step 3:

Cut along the dotted lines and fold along the solid lines.



Step 4:

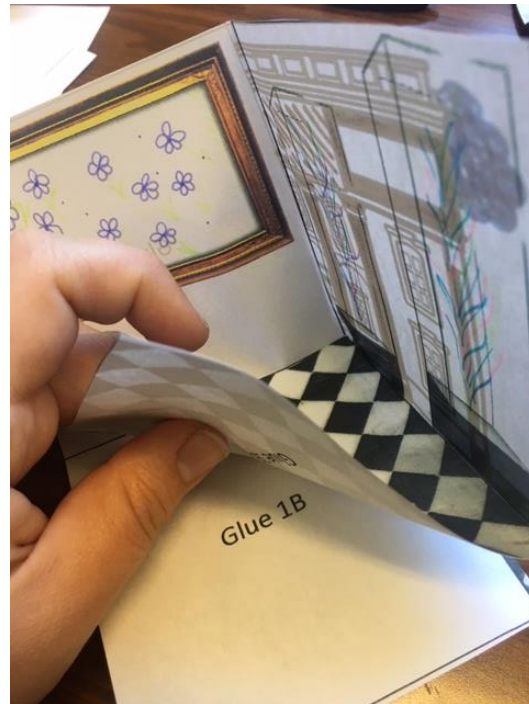
Assemble both pages of the template separately to make it easier to glue. Each template should now be 3D and look like this:

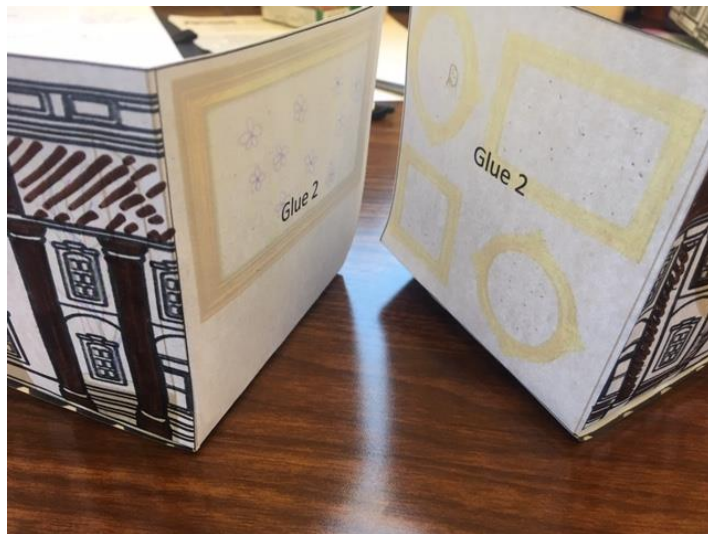
Step 5:

Glue matching numbers and letters. Start by gluing 1A to 1A with the tiled floor on top. Repeat the same steps for 1B (again with the tiled floor on top).



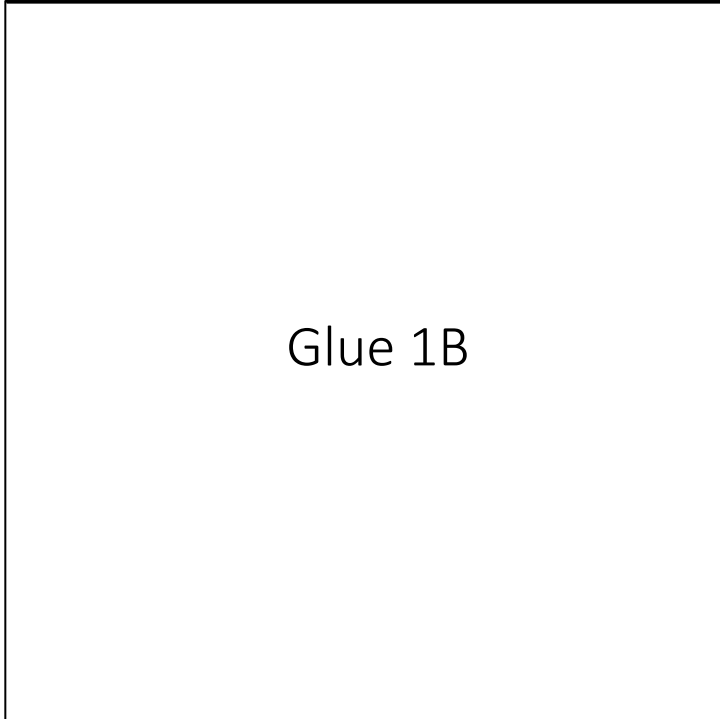
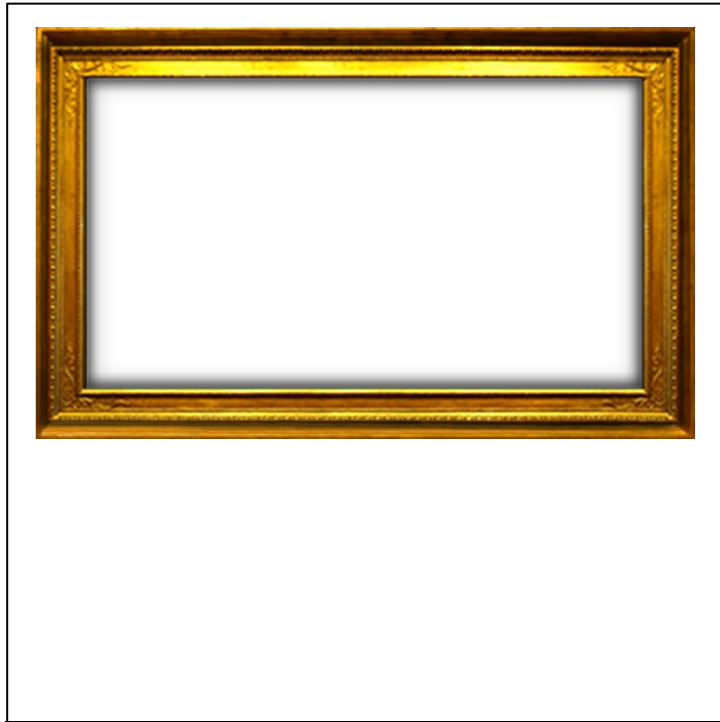
Step 6:

You should now have 2 halves of your museum. Combine both pieces by gluing 2 to 2 and hold them together to be sure they are stuck.

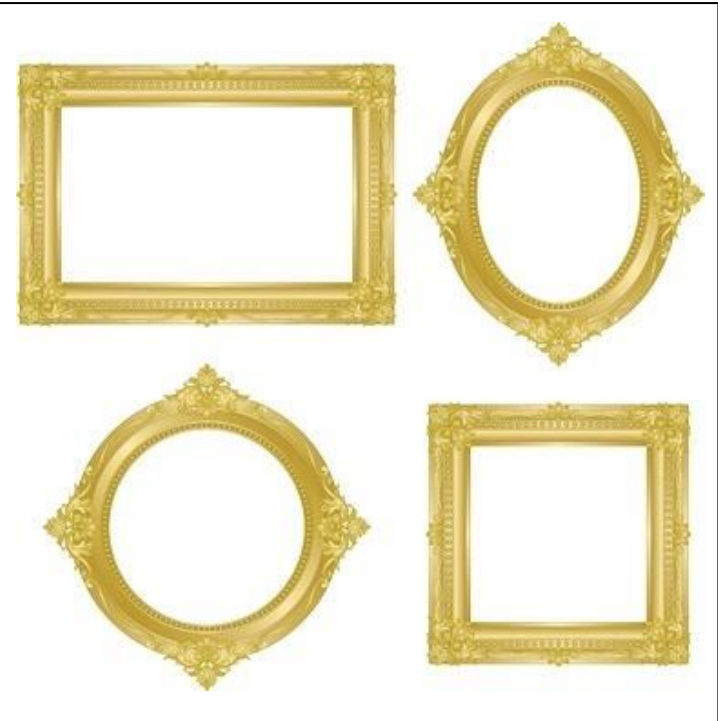
