


# PAMA @ Home Virtual Family Fun Activity Patterned Landscapes


Use basic shapes and a progression of colours to create your own landscape and bring it to life with different prints and patterns.

#### Materials:

- Paper
- Pencil
- Markers/Pencil Crayons/Crayons



**Step 1:** Use your pencil to draw your landscape on a piece of paper.



**Step 2:** Once you have drawn your landscape, outline the lines in black markers.






## Step 3:

Select the shades of colours that you would like to use. You can use as many or as few colours as you would like.



**Step 4:**Colour-in each area of your landscape with different patterns and colours in each area.





## Step 5:

Cover your entire page with colours alternating different patterns throughout until you have a spectrum of colours throughout an abstract landscape.
